There are three specific goals for the development of JBS

- To become an international periodical
- To enhance academic research quality in Taiwan and its international standing
- To be listed in Science Citation Index (SCI) and be included in the top 1,500 journals

- Journal of Biomedical Science was first launched in 1994
- In 1999, JBS was indexed in Journal Citation Reports (JCR), under the category of "Medicine, Research and Experimental"
- Later, further indexed in more than 10 prominent databases, including SCI, MEDLINE, EMBASE, BIOSIS, CA SEARCH, AIDSLINE, TOXLINE, and Life Sciences Collection




Number of submission from 1992-2012




Number of published articles from 2003-2012

<u>Note</u>: This time span includes articles accepted, rejected and withdrawn, which shows average publication time in JBS. Once an article is editorially accepted, it takes about <u>two weeks</u> to publish it in author version. Sometimes shorter if authors respond quickly to production queries about the proofs.

PubMed:

Articles published in JBS are available in PubMed within two weeks of the final version being published, <u>usually 48 hours</u> will due.


Advantages for readers
